You can vary the Loop Stool in terms of structure and thereby appearance, making it perfect for a range of touchdown spaces – from activity-based offices and lounges to bars and restaurants, bus and railway stations or airports. The Loop Stool is available in two heights and is suitable for a variety of different types of tables and environments.

The Loop Stool can be produced in conceptual monochrome, elegant leather upholstered with a leather-wrapped back

support or in a sporty version with technical fabrics and soft cellular plastic in the back support.

*The "loop" of the foot and back supports form a coherent whole, giving the stool a slightly more sporty and lighter expression. The seat is generous and comfortable to sit on, while the back support provides relief for the spine. This means that the stool is even suitable for longer periods of sitting, while the backrest provide relief support in the lower back. This allows the stool for a little longer sitting.*

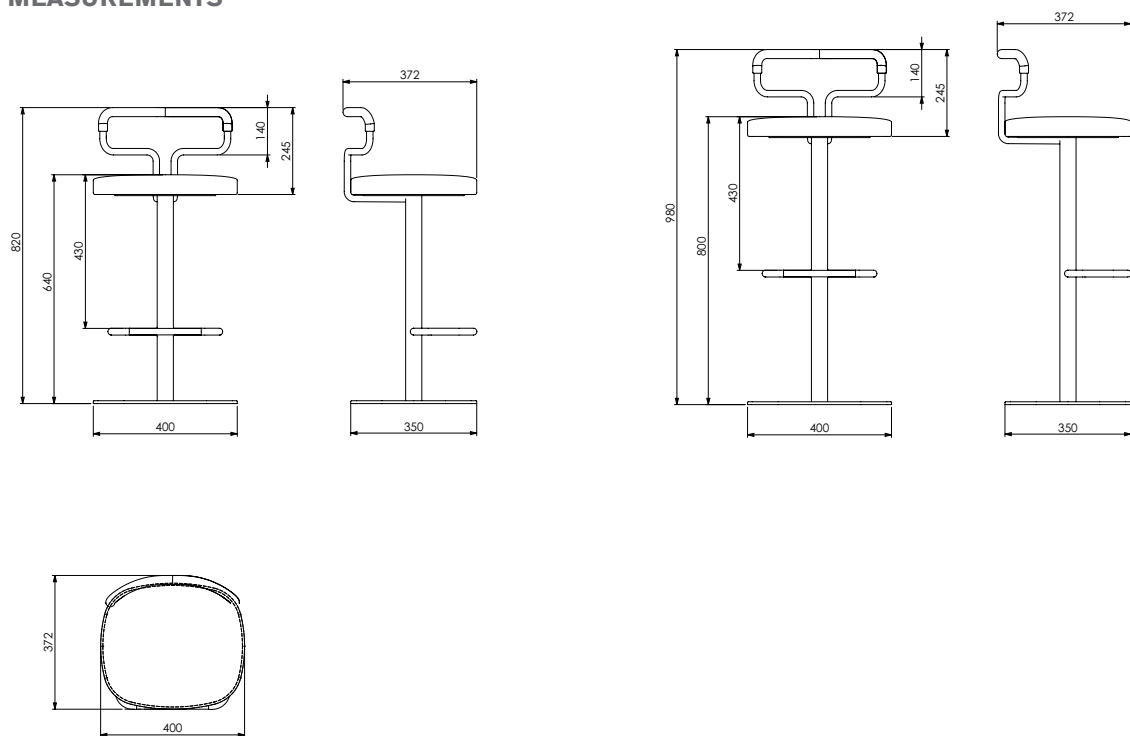

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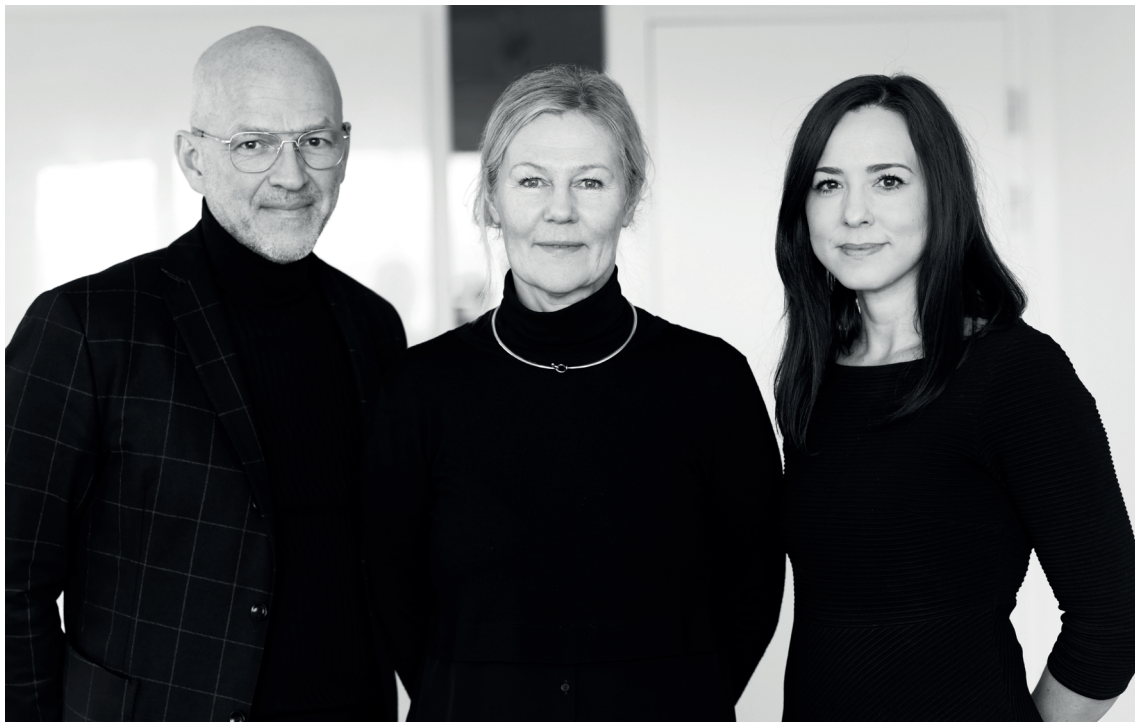
