Hug Chair either come with a back and seat in pressed veneer or with a soft upholstered pad for longer sitting.



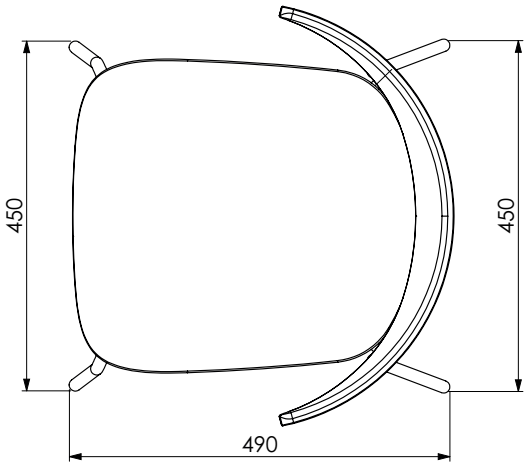
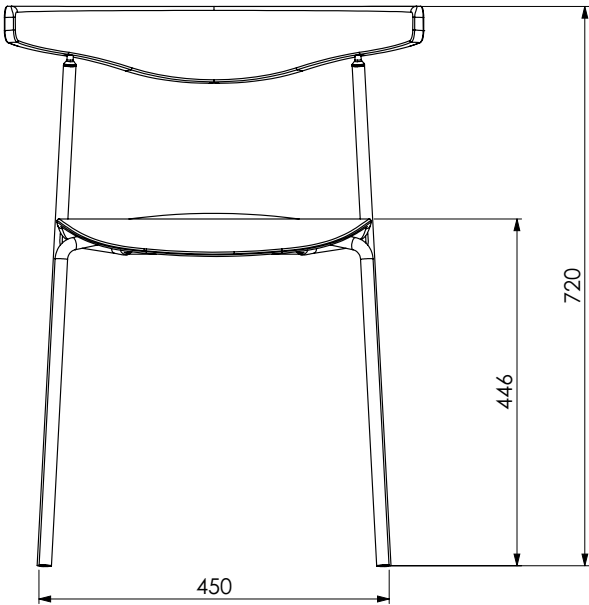
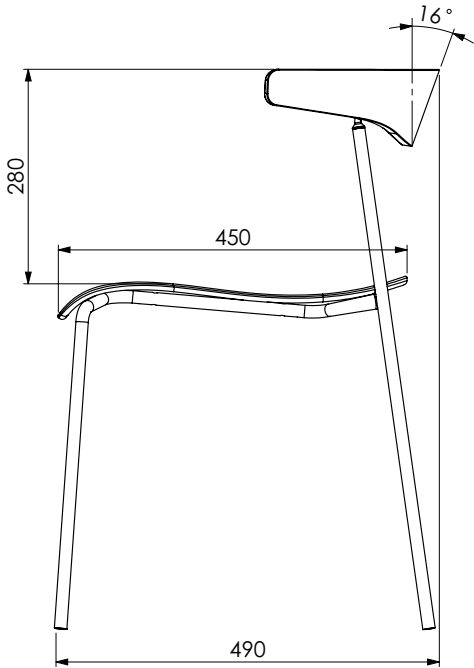
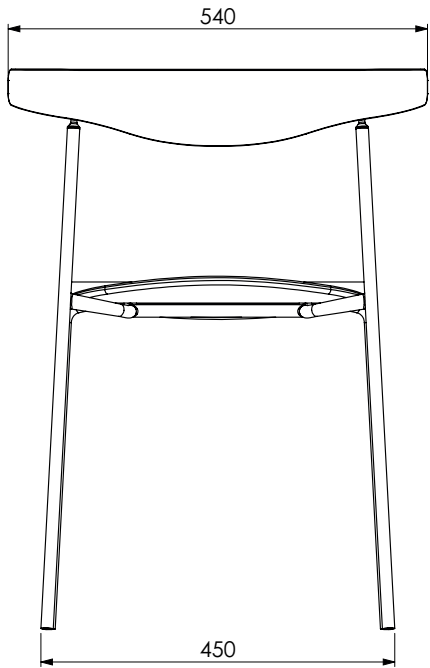
